



ADVISORY NOTICE: CONCLUSIONS RE CEREUS POKER NETWORK

February 4, 2011

Further to the Commission's Advisory Notices of May 7 and 17, 2010, the Commission has completed its assessment of the security issue that was discovered on May 6, 2010. The Commission retained the services of RSA – The Security Division of EMC ("RSA") to perform the assessment of the Cereus Network. RSA conducted external testing and performed a software source code audit of the key components involved in the security issue that was discovered last May.

RSA's final report was recently presented to the Commission and the Commission is satisfied that with the assistance of RSA, the operator of the Cereus Poker Network and the software developer have addressed and corrected the problem that was identified and, in fact, have enhanced the overall security of software and systems in the affected areas.

There is no evidence that the security issue identified on May 6, 2010 resulted in any player gaming data being compromised.
