### REGULATIONS CONCERNING ELECTRONIC GAMING DEVICES

**(MOHAWK TERRITORY OF KAHNAWÀ:KE – 29 March 2018)**—Over the past year, after receiving directions from the Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke (the “Council”), the Kahnawà:ke Gaming Commission (the “Commission”) conducted research and engaged in numerous discussions with experts and interested parties concerning the creation of a regulatory regime for electronic gaming devices to be operated within the Mohawk Territory of Kahnawà:ke. Based on its findings, the Commission prepared and revised numerous drafts of regulations that included, among other things, provisions for testing and certification of equipment and systems, data collection, responsible gaming, player protection—while ensuring the draft regulations would facilitate the operation of electronic gaming devices in the Territory as a socio-economic initiative for the benefit of the Community of Kahnawà:ke.

After receiving confirmation that Council had passed an Executive Decision approving the project, at a regularly scheduled meeting on 28 March 2018, the Commission enacted the *Regulations concerning Electronic Gaming Devices* (the “Regulations”).

It is important to note that on or before six (6) months from the date on which a licence is issued under the Regulations, the Commission will conduct a comprehensive review of the Regulations and of the operations of licensees under Regulations. Following the review, the Commission will determine and implement any amendments to the Regulations, to the licences issued under the Regulations to the operations of licensees under the Regulations as the Commission deems appropriate.

The Mohawk Territory of Kahnawà:ke is a sovereign jurisdiction located just outside Montréal, Québec, Canada. The Kahnawà:ke Gaming Commission was established in 1996 and has been continuously licensing and regulating online and land-based gaming within Kahnawà:ke since that time.
