FOUR ACES POKER ROOM LICENCE SUSPENDED

(MOHAWK TERRITORY OF KAHNAWAKE – July 19, 2011) – At its weekly meeting on July 13, 2011, the Commission issued to Four Aces Poker Room (“Four Aces”), located at Plaza 138, a *Notice of Immediate Suspension*. The suspension of Four Aces’ Poker Room Licence was effective on July 14, 2011.

As a result of this suspension, Four Aces is not permitted to operate unless and until its Poker Room Licence is reinstated.

The Commission has also issued to Four Aces a *Show Cause Notice* giving Four Aces thirty (30) days to show cause as to why its Poker Room Licence should not be revoked.

The Commission’s decision to suspend the Four Aces was based on a number of operational and management concerns, each of which have been clearly conveyed to the licensee.

The Commission will post further updates as this matter develops.
