(MOHAWK TERRITORY OF KAHNAWÀ:KE – 30 January 2019)—The Commission wishes to advise that Magic Palace has successfully completed the three (3) stages of the licensing process set out in the Commission's *Regulations concerning Electronic Gaming Devices* and at today's Commission meeting, was issued an Operator's Licence authorizing Magic Palace to operate Electronic Gaming Devices from a facility located on Highway 132 within the Mohawk Territory of Kahnawà:ke. Magic Palace has been authorized to open its doors to the public on **08 February 2019**.
