## **COMMUNITY CONSULTATION NOTICE**

(MOHAWK TERRITORY OF KAHNAWA:KE – December 13, 2023) The Kahnawa:ke Gaming Commission has received a request to amend the *Regulations concerning Electronic Gaming Devices*.

The following are the proposed amendments:

# Subsection 32(d) be amended as follows:

32. To be considered by the Commission, an application for an Operator's Licence must contain all the information requested in the form attached as Schedule "A" and be accompanied by:

...

 a copy of a contractual agreement demonstrating the applicant has the support of Mohawk Council of Kahnawake. The term of the contractual agreement must be at least three (3) years;

# Subsection 34 be amended as follows:

34. The Commission will consider an application for an Operator's Licence in the following three (3) stages.

Stage 1

To initiate Stage 1, the Commission must receive the following information and documentation:

o fully completed application forms—excepting only Key Person Permit applications required by section 32(c) of these Regulations—and fees, as required by these Regulations;

o a copy of a contractual agreement demonstrating the applicant has the support of  $\underline{\text{the}}$  Mohawk Council of Kahnawake. The term of the contractual agreement must be at least  $\underline{\text{three}}$  (3) years;

### Section 35 be amended as follows:

35. An Operator's Licence will be valid for not more than three (3) five (5) years from the date of issuance, unless extended by the Commission in accordance with the requirements of these Regulations.

### Section 49 be amended as follows:

49. An Operator's Licence will not be granted for a period of time exceeding three (3) five (5) years but may be renewed an unlimited number of times, provided the EGD Operator satisfies the requirements to renew an Operator's Licence as set out in these Regulations.

#### Section 73 be amended as follows:

73. An Operator's Licence will not be renewed unless the EGD Operator provides a copy of a contractual agreement demonstrating the EGD Operator has the support of Mohawk Council of Kahnawake. The term of the contractual agreement must be at least three (3) years in good standing during the term of the Operator's License and at the time of renewal.

#### Section 132 be amended as follows:

132. A Key Person Permit will not be issued for a period exceeding three (3) five (5) years.

## Section 135 be amended as follows:

135. A Key Person Permit may be renewed every three (3) five (5) years by the Commission in accordance with the procedures provided in these Regulations.
